

## THE DETAILS

- ◇ Student hours are 7:40 a.m. - 2:20 p.m.
- ◇ Students have 8 periods in their schedule. Each period is 84 minutes.
- ◇ Uniforms are required. The full dress code policy can be found on our website - [www.oasismiddleschool.net](http://www.oasismiddleschool.net)
- ◇ A full time Cape Coral Police Officer is stationed on our campus, serving as our School Resource Officer (SRO).
- ◇ Our top priority is ensuring students are educated in a safe, secure environment. Our administrative team (principal, assistant principal, dean of students, school counselor, school social worker) works with our school resource officer to provide this for all students.
- ◇ All families are required to volunteer a minimum of 12 hours each school year (once COVID cases are reduced).
- ◇ A fee-based after school program is available to students from 2:20-4:20 p.m. The cost of this program is \$15 per week.
- ◇ Free after-school tutoring is available for students.
- ◇ We put kids first—always making decisions based on what is best for students.
- ◇ We set high expectations for students and staff. All classes at OMS are “Advanced” - appropriate rigor and content.
- ◇ We communicate consistently with parents/guardians, using ParentSquare, Google Classroom and Focus.

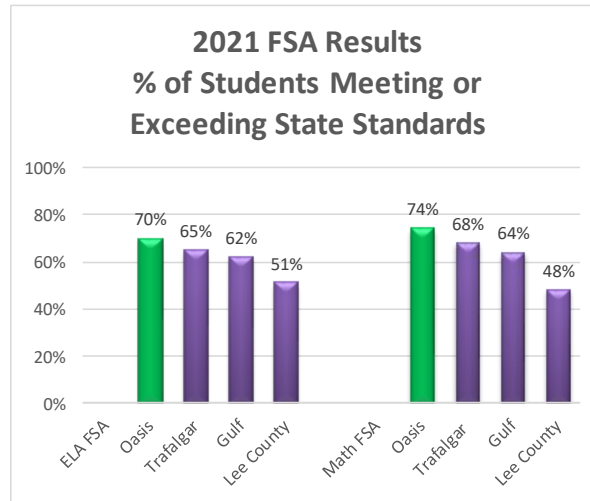


We appreciate parents/guardians, and their involvement in their child’s education. We have a very active PTO, working to make OMS the best place possible for kids, staff, and parents.

## ACADEMICS

The Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) is the State’s standardized test which is administered to all students for reading, writing, and math in 6th, 7th, and 8th grades. The Next Generation Sunshine State Standards (NGSSS) Science is administered to all 8th grade students. 7th grade students take the Civics EOC.



OMS was the highest achieving middle school in Lee County last year—congratulations to our students and staff!

Students who are gifted receive services through our Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) program. High-achieving students may also be in GATE. Students in need of academic support are eligible for free after-school tutoring.

Our STEM program is the strongest in Lee County, with three STEM electives and a full-time MakerSpace.
