

Distance Learning Lunch Option Process

Parents, if a student is enrolled in the Oasis Charter School system and chooses to do distance learning, the school will be providing carry out meals.

It is important to note, that while Oasis Charter Schools offer the NSLP program NOT everyone at our school system is free. If you have already received a letter from the school system stating the family has been approved for the NSLP, then your status is in place for the entire 2020-21 school year. Procedures to order a meal.

Since this process is new, it would be helpful to call a school café with names of the students or at least the number of meals so the school can have the meals ready for pickup. If you forget to call, it may cause a delay but we will take care of your needs.

Procedures to pick up a meal.

Anyone that wants a meal in our school system will need to enter the Oasis campus through the high school and pick up their meals by the high school cafeteria between 9-9:50. The times will have to be enforced to ensure we can serve students on campus. When a parent enters campus, please tell the security guard that you are here to pick up meals. Parents will drive behind the high school and pull up along the high school drive to the OHS café where the tables are sitting outside under an awning. Parents will remain in their cars, staff will check the meals off of a student roster, and a student's meal can be picked up by a parent without the student, as long as they have their student's i.d.'s with them. Acceptable identifications are listed below.

Procedures to pay for a meal.

It is important to note that if a family is reduced or full paying status that they pay for their meals ahead of time. We offer the option of making payments with <u>myschoolbucks.com</u> which can be found on each of our websites under the Parent Portal under lunch information.

Valid forms of student identification

Valid forms of identification may include, but are not limited to, school identification card, child's passport, government-issued child identification card, or any document proving parent/guardian identity and relationship to the child, such as an adoption decree; doctor, clinic or hospital record; religious record; or daycare center record.
